Class members are expected to attend all sessions, actively participate, and complete the occasional homework assignments. The year after graduation, participants help plan and facilitate one Challenge Day for the following year's class. You may miss up to 16-hours of class and graduate from the program. As an experience based program, missing more than 16-hours would prevent you from graduating.
