Leadership Thurston County (LTC) Class of 2027 is a 10-month community immersion program that begins in September 2026 and ends in June 2027. The curriculum explores issues affecting our community through panel, presentations, discussions, and site visits with established leaders, and other activities.

Challenge Days are designed to be complementary to each other; you are expected to attend all sessions, actively participate, and complete the homework assignments. You may miss up to 25-hours of class and graduate from the program. As a participation-based program, missing more than 25-hours would prevent you from graduating. **Attending an Orientation Session & the Opening Retreat in September is required for participation.**

Tuition for the 2026-2027 year is \$2900, plus applicable sales tax. Full tuition payment is due August 7, 2026. **Payment plans may be arranged but must be requested in writing by June 12th. Please contact the LTC Director for information.**
